From the hills of the Rift Valley around Mövenpick Nabatean Castle Hotel, it is just 10 minutes by car to Petra, the historic Nabatean kingdom that is now Jordan's most visited attraction. The fitting fort-like architecture of this five-star hotel complements stunning views that provide some natural respite and perspective after a day exploring Petra, the UNESCO World Heritage Site also known as the Rose City.

Guests benefit from the impressive views, complimentary Wi-Fi in the 91 rooms and suites, which were completely renovated in 2018 with new tile flooring, showers, bathroom fixtures and soft furnishings.

With a daily-changing variety of Jordanian specialities, international dishes, salads and desserts. Al Madafa restaurant is a great place for hearty appetites. Al Nadeem's cocktails and alcoholic refreshments complement excellent views for the perfect sun downer. The hotel also features an organic garden that is frequented by the chefs. In winter, the indoor swimming pool is heated and several outdoor terraces are great for reading and meditation. Excursions to other parts of Jordan can be arranged.

	including Lawrence of Arabia. With soaring mountains, vast plains



and ancient Bedouin history, this is a unique Jordanian experience that features awe-inspiring rock formations.

Dana Biosphere Reserve

This incredible eco-system features more than 600 plant species, around 180 bird species and more than 40 different types of mammals, including gazelles, foxes and wolves. Additionally there are almost 100 archaeological sites based in the reserve.

Hiking and cross-country trekking

The Jordan Trail covers sections throughout the country, including a four-day hike from Dana to Petra and a five-day stretch from Petra to Wadi Rum. The hotel can also arrange excursions (at a fee) to the Dead Sea, Aqaba, the Red Sea and the 12th century Crusader castles at Shobak and Kerak.
